Traffic free
 Cycle route - away from road: Shared with pedestrians, usually well surfaced; Route access point - easy access
 Cycle route - on pavement: Shared with pedestrians, usually well surfaced

Footpath
 Cycling not permitted, dismount and walk with your cycle

Usually traffic free
 Bridleway / track / other: Surfacing varies from tarmac/adam to untreated surface, can be muddy or rough, may only be seasonally cycleable, and not suitable for narrow tyres

On road
 Separate cycle lane on the road

Routes
 St Albans Green Ring: Traffic free; On road
 National Cycle Network: 57; Chiltern Cycle Way: C

Routes suggested by local cyclists: Usually quieter roads, may include busier link sections
